

COMMUNIQUE

In order to ensure compliance with Article 56 (2) of Law No. 1/92, of January 3, the Board of Directors of the Banco de Moçambique, in the use of the powers conferred thereto by Article 46 of the aforementioned Law, has decided to hold the 48th meeting of the Advisory Board of the institution between November 1 to 3 in Inhambane city.

The Advisory Board constitutes an extended consultative body of the Board of Directors, which meets regularly once a year and extraordinarily whenever convened by the Governor.

The duties of the body are as follows:

- a) advising on matters regarding the Bank's activities and the national economy;
- b) advising on matters regarding the Bank's organization and operations;
- c) advising on matters expressly entrusted to the body by the Board of Directors; and
- d) take stock of activities and plan future actions.

The first two days of the event, November 1 and 2, 2023, are reserved for presenting and evaluating internal matters of the Banco de Moçambique. On the third day, November 3, 2023, the topic "**Challenges and Opportunities for Maximizing Mozambique's Tourism Potential: the Case of Inhambane Province**", will be presented and discussed in a public session at complexo Nyeledzi, in Inhambane city.

In light of the importance and nature of the topic set for the third day, interested parties and the general public are hereby informed of the following:

- a) Applications to participate in the public session are now open, and any travel and accommodation expenses shall be borne by the participants;

- c) Application shall require that applicants provide, among others, the following details:
 - Full name;
 - Nationality;
 - Training (level and course)
 - Current occupation, while stating the company or field;
 - Address and contact (telephone and/or e-mail address).

For organizational reasons, only the first 20 (twenty) applicants will be accepted.
