As of September 30, 2021, the LMR was 14,001.85%, decreased by 14,951.03% when compared to June 30, 2021. This is mainly driven by decrease in the average liquefiable assets during the quarter.

As of September 30, 2021, the CAR was 203.13%, decreased by 213.16% when compared to June 30, 2021. This is majorly driven by higher market risk exposures as compared to previous quarter.
