The tenderers are requested to go through the E – tendering terms and conditions, General terms and conditions of the Tender, Terms and Conditions for Reverse Auction (e-auction) and Process Compliance Statement carefully.

The due date for submission of Tender documents including the Technical Cum Commercial Bid along with Tender fee/EMD and the Price bid online through E-procurement portal (https://tntenders.gov.in/nicgep/app) is 29.05.2023 on or before 3:00 PM. The Technical Cum Commercial Bid will be opened through online portal at 04:00 PM on 30.05.2023.

TENDER OPENING AND TECHNICAL BID EVALUATION

- a. Technical Bid opening will be done online and technical evaluation will be carried out after the due date of submission of online Bid.
- b. TNPL will examine the Technical Bids against the Qualifying criteria and Technical cum Commercial bid given in the Tender document.
- c. Evaluation will be done based on the documents submitted by the Bidder. The Bids which are not meeting Qualifying criteria will be rejected and further processing will not be carried out.
- d. The tenderers, on their own interest, should ensure that all the documents required are furnished. Tenders received without the relevant documents would summarily be rejected
- e. Decision of TNPL is final and no dispute can be raised by any Bidder for rejection of their Bids and no claims on this account will be entertained.
- f. The Bidders whose Bids meet the Qualifying Criteria and Technical specifications of the tender will be called as "Technically Qualified Bidders".
- g. In case if the Bidder fails to comply with the requirements of TNPL, such Bids will be rejected without entertaining further correspondence in this regard.

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Technically qualified bidders price Bid will be opened by TNPL tender opening committee at Purchase section, Kagithapuram through https://tntenders.gov.in/nicgep/app.

Tenderers who do not comply with the conditions with documentary proof (wherever required) will not be qualified in the Tender for Price bid opening and E-reverse auction stage.

OPENING OF THE PRICE BIDS:

The date and time of opening of Price Bids will be later notified through registered Mobile number and email to the Bidders who fulfill the tender terms and conditions through NIC portal.

Note: At the price bid stage, TNPL would adopt the following methodology to finalize the tender.

- (a) Technical Bid is to be filled in the given format & uploaded.
- (b) Price Bid (BOQ) is to be filled in the given format & uploaded.
- (c) In the e-tender, the price bids received from the technically qualified bidders will be opened electronically.
- (d) The opening price for the e-auction will be the lowest price obtained in the price bid/ TNPL will fix opening price. The minimum bid decrement, opening price, the date and time of e-auction (https://tntenders.gov.in/nicgep/app) will be communicated to the qualified parties through your registered Mobile number and E-mail ID in NIC portal.
- (e) The lowest offer received either through e-portal price bid (BOQ) or through e-auction whichever is lower, will only be considered for placement of order.

Further, if the bidders offer is not qualified as per the qualifying factor mentioned in the tender, their price bid (BOQ) will not be opened.

PLEASE NOTE THAT FOLLOWING ARE QUALIFYING CONDITIONS OF THIS TENDER FOR OPENING OF PRICE BID (POINT NO.1 TO 6 below):

LOADABILITY:

Tenderers shall quote their rate per MT basis and can operate 10,12,14 & 16 Wheel Trucks. Considering the nature of material, the loadability of 16,14,12 & 10 wheel trucks will be around 28 MT, 26 MT, 22 MT & 18 MT respectively. TNPL does not guarantee for loadability given and the quantity may vary on either side. However considering the variations in unladen weight of different kinds of trucks and nature of material, Payment will be made for the actual quantity of material transported & received at TNPL Unit-I, Kagithapuram weighbridge weight.

As per notification dated 03.09.2018 provided by Transport Commissioner, the loading weight of transport vehicles have been increased. However, stamping needs to be done in RC/Permit for increase in safe axle weight of transport vehicles.

Also it is the responsibility of the tenderers to take care of the RTO regulations for load restrictions under section 114 of Motor vehicles act 88 and any restriction on load limitation by Tamil Nadu Lorry Owners Federation and any other statutory regulations.

Please note that the following points asked for in the **Commercial Bid** are the qualifying factors of the Tender. Therefore tenderers who do not comply with the conditions with documentary proof (wherever required) will not be qualified in the Tender for Price Bid stage.



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01. EXPERIENCE:

The tenderer should have minimum two years experience in transporting bulk materials by Truck not less than 2000 MT in any one month in the past two years, i.e., Financial Year 2021-22 / 2022-23.

- Documentary proof should be enclosed along with tender document for experience in the form of purchase/work order copies / transport agreements for past TWO FINANCIAL YEARS.
- ✓ Documentary proof should be enclosed for quantity transported should not be less than 2000 MT in any one month in the past two financial years, i.e., 2021-22 / 2022-23 in the form of G.C.copies / copies of Bills/Invoices with payment vouchers / payment details through RTGS.

Tender received without year wise documentary proof for experience and quantity transported as above shall be rejected summarily without assigning any reasons whatsoever.

<u>02.The Transporters have to ensure the trucks supplied by them are provided with GPS facility, which can be tracked by TNPL also.</u>

03. QUANTITY COMMITMENT (MINIMUM):

The tenderer shall be in a position to transport minimum quantity of 60 MT Debarked Subabul Pulpwood per day on weekly average basis. Those who are not able to commit the above minimum quantity will not be qualified for the price bid opening. The entire tender quantity of 5,000 MT has to be transported within <u>3 Months</u> from the date of order.

04. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD) AND TENDER FEE:

EMD: **EMD** of **Rs 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakhs)** should be submitted along with the Technical cum Commercial Bid through RTGS/NEFT mode.

TENDER FEE: In case, the tenderer has downloaded the tender document from websites, Tender Fee of **Rs.590/-** is to be remitted through RTGS/NEFT mode.

The remittance details of both Tender fee and EMD (UTR details) should also be furnished in the Technical cum Commercial Bid.

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➤ The EMD of successful tenderer shall be converted into Security Deposit and the same will be returned after satisfactory completion of order. The Security Deposit shall not bear any interest.

EMD amount will not bear any interest and will be returned to the unsuccessful bidders after releasing the order.

05. The contractors who had worked earlier for TNPL and whose performance was found bad/unsatisfactory/blacklisted will not be considered. TNPL's decision is final in this regard.

06. TERMS OF PAYMENT:

- a) Payment will be made for the actual quantity of material transported & received at TNPL Unit-I, Kagithapuram weighbridge weight. 100% Payment on or before 10 days from date of receipt of invoice through RTGS.
- b) Income-tax or any other taxes and duties which the transport company may be required to pay by Law, shall be deducted at source and the same shall be paid to the authorities concerned on the account of transport contractor. TNPL shall provide the required deduction certificates.
- c) Applicable GST & APFDC CESS amount if any extra to TNPL account.
- d) Bills for the job carried shall be submitted to the company in duplicate once in 15 days and the bills shall contain the following particulars.
 - i) Purchase order Number and date
 - ii) Description of the consignment
 - iii) Date of bookings
 - iv) Originating station and destination along with particulars of weight actually recorded at main site and offsite weight bridges.
 - v) Lorry receipt/consignment note duly certified by authorized representatives of the company at Offsite / Paper Mill Site to the effect that the consignment has been safely delivered.

Note: I. In case of bills submitted with errors in the above particulars the bill shall be returned to the contractors and the same shall be resubmitted after corrections. The date of resubmission will be treated as the date of submission of bill.

Note: II. In case of loss of acknowledgement copy of LR/CN/GC, the Duplicate of the same should be obtained within 20 days. Therefore TNPL will not be responsible for non production of LR/CN/GC/non settlement of payment. Indemnity bond in Non-Judicial Stamp Paper for the value of Rs.80/- (Rupees eighty only) for each LR/CN/GC shall be executed in the prescribed format issued by TNPL.

Note: III. If any corrections are there in the bill, it is to be rectified within 3 days after submission of the bill.

e) The Contractor shall ensure that the bill is submitted for complete transportation for the particular period. Submission of supplementary bills should be avoided. The supplementary bills shall be raised only for missing LR/CN/GCs after getting duplicate acknowledgement within 30 days of LR/CN/GC date. Otherwise such supplementary bills are liable for rejection/non-payment by TNPL.

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The Price Bid of those who fail to furnish the above details will not be considered.

OPENING OF THE PRICE BIDS:

The date and time of opening of Price Bids will be later notified through registered e-mail to the Bidders who fulfill the tender terms and conditions.

<u>Loading at ONGOLE Depot, Andhra Pradesh & Unloading at TNPL, Unit-1, Kagithapuram will be done by TNPL.</u>

The Earnest Money Deposit shall be returned to the un-successful bidders on finalization of tender and for successful tenderers, the EMD will be converted into interest free Security Deposit which shall be returned only after satisfactory completion of the contract.

VALIDITY OF OFFER:

The rate quoted against the tender should be valid for acceptance for 90 days from the date of opening of Commercial Bid and during the validity period of the offer, the bidder is not permitted to make any upward revision in the rate or withdraw his offer. In case of withdrawal of offer or revision of rate as stated above, the EMD amount will be forfeited and suitable penal action will be taken. The contract shall be valid for a period of three months from the date of award of purchase order.

The Tender form is not transferable. TNPL reserves its right to award contract to any number of transporters for based on the capability of the transporter to undertake the work. TNPL reserves its right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS FOR SUBMISSION OF ONLINE BIDS IN E-TENDER

Techno-commercial bids and price bids should be submitted through the following link https://tntenders.gov.in/nicgep/app

The tender will be processed online through e-tender and e-reverse auction. The bidder shall submit his response through bid submission to the tender in the online procurement platform at NIC's website https://tntenders.gov.in/nicgep/app. No other forms of bid submission is accepted. Bidders are requested to quote their price through the online e-procurement portal/system only.

The procedures to be followed are explained below:

- a) Techno-Commercial Bids are to be filled in the given formats attached. The required and mandatory formats are available in the Tender Document in the e-portal.
- b) Price Bids are to be filled in the e-portal in the relevant web pages enabled for the bidders. Price bids will be opened before- reverse auction.
- <u>Bidders are requested to read the instructions and terms & conditions carefully before submitting their online tenders.</u>
- The Bidders are required to submit soft copies of their Bids electronically on the TAMILNADU GOVERNMENT E PROCUREMENT Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The necessary instructions are given to assist the Bidders in registering on the TAMILNADU GOVERNMENT E PROCUREMENT Portal, prepare their Bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their Bids online on the TAMILNADU GOVERNMENT E PROCUREMENT Portal.

The bidding under this contract is electronic bid submission through website https://tntenders.gov.in/nicgep/app only. Detailed guidelines for viewing bids and submission of online bids are given on the website. The bidder's can logon to this website and view the invitation for Bids and can view the details of Materials /works for which bids are invited.

1 REGISTRATION:

- 1.1 The bidders needs to submit bids online. However, the bidders are required tohave enrolment/registration in the website by clicking on the link "Online bidder enrolment" which is free of charge.
- 1.2 As part of the enrolment process, the bidders are required to choose a unique user name
 - and assign a password for their accounts.
- 1.3 Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile number as part of the registration process. These details would be used for any communication from the e-Portal
- 1.4 Upon enrolment, the bidders are required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) (Class Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.
- 1.5 Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders should ensure that they do not lend their DSC to others which may lead to misuse.
- 1.6 Bidder then can login to the site through the secured login by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

3.0 SYSTEM REQUIREMENT:

- i. Operating System: Windows 7 or above, RAM 1GB and above
- ii. Internet connectivity with at least 2 Mbps speed
- iii. Internet browser: IE 9 and above (or) Mozilla Firefox 3.5 up to version 49
- iv. Signing type: Digital Signature (class III)
- v. JRE 8.0 software to be downloaded and installed in the system.

To enable ALL active X controls and disable 'use pop up blocker' under Tools→ Internet Options→ custom level (Please run IE settings once)

4.0 SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENT:

- **4.1** There are various search options built in the Website, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, organization name, location, date, value, etc.
- 4.2 Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents/tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective 'My Tenders' folder. This would enable the Tamil Nadu Govt. e-Procurement Portal, to intimate the bidders through SMS / e-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- **4.3** The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

5.0 PREPARATION OF BIDS:

- **5.1** Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.
- 5.2 Bidders are requested to go through the NIT and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
- 5.3 Bidders, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF / JPG formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi, which helps in reducing size of the scanned document. Since the uploaded documents shall be downloaded for evaluation of bid, bidders are advised to <u>upload clear scanned</u> copies.
- **5.4** The completed bid comprising scanned copy of the proof for the payment of Tender fee, EMD and necessary technical and commercial documents should be uploaded on the website along with signed and scanned copies of requisite certificates are mentioned in the different sections in the tender document.

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6.0 PROCEDURE FOR ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION OF BIDS:

The bidder shall submit online the requirements under qualification criteria and Technical Documents required and Price Schedule/BOQ. All the documents are required to be signed digitally by the bidder. After electronic online bid submission, the system generates a unique bid reference number which is time stamped. This shall be treated as acknowledgement of bid submission.

- 6.1 Bidder should log- in to the site well in advance for Bid submission so that they can upload the Bid in time i.e. on or before the Bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- 6.2 The Bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required Bid documents one by one as indicated in the Bid document.
- 6.3 Bidder has to select the payment option as "offline" to pay the tender fee and EMD as applicable and enter details of the instrument.
- 6.4 Bidder should prepare and submit the Tender fee & EMD as per the instructions specified in the Bid document.
- 6.5 Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their price Bids in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price Bid has been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by the Bidder. Bidders are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the Blue colored (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the Bidder etc). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the Bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the Bidder, the Bid will be rejected
- 6.6 The server time (which is displayed on the Bidders' dash board) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the Bids by the Bidders, opening of Bids etc. The Bidders should follow this time during Bid submission.
- 6.7 All the documents being submitted by the Bidders would be encrypted to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of Bid opening. The confidentiality of the Bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128 bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done. Any Bid document that is uploaded to the server is subjected to symmetric encryption using a system generated symmetric key. Further this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers/Bid openers public keys.
- 6.8 The uploaded Bid documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized Bid openers
- 6.9 Upon the successful and timely submission of Bid (i.e., after Clicking "Freeze Bid Submission" in the portal), the portal will give a successful Bid submission message & a Bid summary will be displayed with the Bid no. and the date & time of submission of the Bid with all other relevant details.

6.10 The Bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement of the submission of the Bid.

6.11 In all cases, Bidders should use their own ID and Password along with Digital Signature certificate at the time of submission of their Bid.



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- 6.12 During the entire e-tender process, the Bidders will remain completely anonymous to one another and also to everybody else.
- 6.13 The e-tender floor shall remain open from the pre-announced date & time till the specified due date & time.
- 6.14 The electronic Bid submitted during the e-tender process shall be legally binding on the Bidder. Any Bid will be considered as valid only if it is submitted in the prescribed format given in the Bid document.
- 6.15 It is mandatory that all the Bids are submitted with digital signature certificate otherwise the same will not be accepted by the system.
- 6.16 TNPL reserves the right to cancel or reject or accept or withdraw or extend the due date for submission of Bid as the case may be without assigning any reason thereof.
- 6.17 The NIC server time shall be treated as final and binding. Bids recorded in the server before the Bid closing time will only be treated as valid Bid. Bidders are, therefore, advised to submit their Bids well before the closing time of e-tender. If any Bid reaches the server after the Bid closing time as per server time, the same will not be recorded and no complaint in this regard shall be entertained. TNPL is not responsible for any sort of delay or the difficulties faced during the submission of Bids online by the Bidders due to local issues.
- 6.18 Bidders are advised to exercise caution in submitting their Bids in e-tender and e-Reverse Auction, as the case may be, to avoid any mistake. Bids once submitted can't be recalled.
- 6.19 Any order resulting from this Bidding process shall be governed by the terms and conditions mentioned in the Bid Documents.
- 6.20 No deviation to the technical and commercial terms & conditions are acceptable.

6.21 Bidders are required to sign in each page of the Bid specification.

6.22 TNPL may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids by amending the bidding document, in which case all rights and obligations of TNPL and bidders subject to the previous deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline extended.

7.0 LATE BID:

The Electronic bidding system would not allow any late submission of bids after due date and time, as per server time.

8.0 MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS:

- 8.1 Bidders may modify their bids online before the deadline for submission of bids.
- 8.2 In case a bidder intends to modify his bid online before the deadline, the bidder need not make any additional payment towards the cost of bid processing. For bid modification and consequential re-submission, the bidder is not required to withdraw his bid submitted earlier. Modification and consequential re-submission of bids is allowed any number of times. The last modified bid submitted by the bidder within the bid submission time shall be considered as the bid. For this purpose, modification/withdrawal by other means will not be accepted. The bidder may withdraw his bid by uploading his request before the deadline for submission of bids, however, if the bid is withdrawn, the re-submission of the bid is not allowed.
- 8.3 No bid may be modified after the deadline for submission of Bids.

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9.0 ASSISTANCE TO BIDDERS:

- 9.1 Any queries relating to the tender document and the terms and conditions contained therein should be addressed to the Tender Inviting Authority for a tender or the relevant contact person / email ID indicated in the Notice inviting tender.
- 9.2 Any gueries relating to the process of online bid submission or gueries in general may be directed to the 24x7 Central Public Procurement Portal Helpdesk.

It may be noted by the bidders that NIC is only a service provider for conducting the online bidding process against this tender and shall not be a party to any contract between TNPL and the successful bidder(s) subsequent to the bidding process.

10.0 SUBMISSION OF HARD COPIES OF DOCUMENTS, IF REQUIRED

The Bidders needs to submit all the documents through online submission. However, the required documents should be submitted in Hard copies after online submission, if demanded from TNPL.

11.0 E - TENDER AND E- REVERSE AUCTION

- 11.1In e-tender, price Bids received from Technically Qualified Bidders only will be opened, electronically. The opening price for the e - auction will be the lowest price obtained in the price bid. Technically Qualified Bidders only will be allowed to participate in the E- Reverse auction process.
- 11.2 After opening of the Price Bid, the Bidders who shall become eligible to participate in the Reverse Auction as per the conditions stated in this Document, known as the Qualified Bidders, will be intimated about their qualification through notification on the https://tntenders.gov.in/nicgep/app website within their secured login as well as a system generated email. It shall be the sole responsibility of the Bidder to regularly check the https://tntenders.gov.in/nicgep/app website and log in to see whether they have qualified or not. TNPL will not be responsible for non-receipt of email by the Bidder and its consequences.
- 11.3 E-Bidding is the process of inviting final price offers from the Qualified Bidders through internet for the purpose of determination of the lowest Bidder (i.e the Bidder who submits the lowest price Bid in the Reverse Auction).
- 11.4 The Qualified Bidder will remain anonymous to other Qualified Bidders participating in the electronic Bidding process. The Qualified Bidder will be able to see the prevailing lowest price Bid, but the name of the current L1 Bidder at any point of time will not be displayed. The Qualified Bidder shall have to put his price Bid below the displayed current L1 Bid by decrement as specified in above point, to become the L1 Bidder. The lowest price obtained after completion of the Reverse Auction Process, shall be the Closing Price and the bidder quoting the same will be considered as the L1 bidder.
- 11.5 The electronic Bidding process for E-reverse auction will have a scheduled start and close time which will be displayed on screen. A Qualified Bidder will be able to put his price Bid after the start of Bid time and till the close time of electronic Bidding. The current server time (IST) will also be displayed on the screen. In the event a Bid is received during the last 10 (ten) minutes before the scheduled close time of electronic Bidding the close time of electronic Bidding will be automatically extended by 10 (ten) minutes from the last received Bid time to give equal opportunity to all other Qualified Bidders. This process of auto extension will continue till there is a period of 10 (ten) minutes during which no price Bids are received.

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11.6 During the tender process for electronic Bidding the Bidder shall be required to sign their Bids with their respective digital signature certificate (DSC) which has been used to login. 

01. SCOPE OF WORK:

The detailed scope of work shall be as follows.

- a) Transportation of debarked SUBABUL pulpwood from ONGOLE Depot (TNPL Authorized) Weighbridge, Andhra Pradesh to TNPL Unit-1, Kagithapuram. Placement of requisite number of Truck should be arranged by the contractor as instructed by TNPL Official with a minimum notice of 24 hours.
- b) The required trucks should be placed at Depot (TNPL Authorized) Weighbridge, Andhra Pradesh on day-to day basis.
- c) Loading of debarked SUBABUL pulpwood at ONGOLE Depot (TNPL Authorized) Weighbridge, Andhra Pradesh & Unloading at TNPL Unit-I, Kagithapuram will be arranged by TNPL. Otherwise, such supplementary bills are liable for rejection/non-payment by TNPL.
- **18**. TDS as per Income Tax Act will be deducted from your bill. Necessary TDS certificate shall be issued by TNPL.

19. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD) AND TENDER FEE:

EMD: **EMD** of **Rs 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakhs)** should be submitted along with the Technical cum Commercial Bid through RTGS/NEFT mode.



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TENDER FEE: In case, the tenderer has downloaded the tender document from websites, Tender Fee of **Rs.590/**- is to be remitted through RTGS/NEFT mode.

The remittance details of both Tender fee and EMD (UTR details) should also be furnished in the Technical cum Commercial Bid.

20. REJECTION/ACCEPTANCE OF TENDER:

TNPL will not assign any reason for rejection of tender. The acceptance of tender rests with TNPL which does not bind itself to accept and TNPL reserve the right to reject any or all tenders or to split up the quantum of work to more number of contractors.

21. If at any time, after the commencement of the work, TNPL does not require the whole work or part of the work to be carried out for any reason whatsoever, TNPL shall give a notice in writing of the fact to the transporter who shall have no claim to any payment or compensation whatsoever on account of any profit or advantage which he might have derived from the execution of work in full.

22. CANCELLATION:

In the event of cancellation of contract due to failure of the transporter to comply with the terms of the contract, the retention money and Security Deposit shall be forfeited by TNPL without prejudice. TNPL also reserves the right to claim compensation for the losses incurred, if any.

23. The Transporter shall adhere to all the safety and Security regulations at the loading (Ongole Depot, Andhra Pradesh) premises and at our site premises without any exceptions. All safety precautions with respect to movement of vehicle at the loading point and our TNPL factory premises shall be strictly adhered to.

24. TENDERS LIABLE FOR REJECTION:

The following tenders are liable for rejection summarily:

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25. The rates quoted shall be inclusive of taxes and duties and free from escalation except for diesel price compensation clause as detailed below. Otherwise, the rates shall be firm and valid till completion of the contract. The taxes if any shall be clearly indicated in the quotation. Otherwise, it will not be considered during the currency of work order.

26. FORMULA FOR REVISION IN DIESEL PRICE (INCREASE/DECREASE):

If the Diesel price increases/decreases beyond 5%, the freight rates will be revised as per the formula given below and the revisions (increase/decrease) in freight rate will be effected after 15 days from the date of diesel price revision. (However in case the first increase/decrease from the Present Rate is below 5%, the freight rates will be revised whenever the cumulative increase/decrease reaches 5% from the present diesel price). Accordingly subsequent revisions will be effected whenever cumulative increase/decrease reaches beyond 5% from the revised rate.

The increase/decrease in freight per MT = <u>For every 5% increase or decrease in diesel price</u>, the transport charges will be increased / decreased by 1%.

If there is any increase / decrease in diesel price beyond 5% between the period of tender opening to issue of Purchase Order, the negotiated rates shall be revised, based on the above formula.

During the currency of the contract, escalation on any account whatsoever, will not be entertained, other than the Diesel Price variation as detailed above.

27. GOODS & SERVICE TAX:

Goods & Service Tax and APFDC CESS (if any) will be extra at actuals to TNPL Account and the same will be paid directly by TNPL to the authorities concerned. The contractor should submit the bills in duplicate along with acknowledged GC copies in duplicate. (The duplicate copy should be in the form of printed / carbon copy. Photo copy / Xerox copy will not be accepted.)

28. JURISDICTION:

The Contract shall be deemed to have been entered into at Kagithapuram, Karur Dist and the Court at Karur shall be the forum for legal proceedings, if any, connected with this contract.

- **29**. The transporter shall not assign or sublet the contract or any part thereof or allow any per son to become interested therein in any manner, whatsoever, without specific \ written permission from TNPL.
- **30**. The transporter shall at all times indemnify TNPL against all claims, damages or compensation under the provisions of workmen's compensation Act, Payment of wages act, Goods Carrier Act and all other acts and laws and any rules and regulations made there under as modified and in force from time to time or as a consequence of any accident or injury to any work man or other persons in or about the works whether in the employment of the contractor or not. The transporter shall also indemnify TNPL against levy of any taxes, Loss of Goods in transit etc in regard to this contract and in the event of TNPL being assessed for any of the said imposts, TNPL shall have the right to recover the total amount so assessed from your dues and the transporter shall also be responsible for all costs or expenses that may be incurred due to litigations in respect of the same.

31. TRANSPORTER LIABLE FOR DAMAGE DONE:

If the transporter or his employee shall break, deface injure or destroy any part of a building premises in which they may be working or any other building, roads, fence, enclosures, water pipes, cables, drains, electric or telephone post or wires or any cultivated materials while in progress from any cause whatsoever, the contractor shall make the same good at his own expense and in default, TNPL may do the work by any other agency and deduct the expenses (of which the certificate of TNPL shall be final) from any sums that may be then, or at any time thereafter become due to contractor, or from his security deposit or any other deposit.



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32. INSURANCE FOR WORKMEN EMPLOYED BY THE TRANSPORTER

The transporter should submit Insurance Policy under workmen compensation Act for the staff/workmen engaged for co-ordination work by them for the entire contract period before commencement of work. TNPL is not responsible for any accidents occurred to employees of transporters/any other person engaged in the transporting operations.

- a) The Transporter shall faithfully comply with the provisions of the Factories Act 1948, ESI Act 1948, the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) ACT -1970, the Workmen's Compensation Act 1923, Employees Provident Fund Act 1952 and any other law for the time being in force and applicable to contract workmen for the staff/workmen engaged for co-ordination work by them for the entire contract period before commencement of work. The Transporter shall fully indemnify the Company for any loss or damage or any liability incurred by the Company due to any default or non observance by the transporter of any of the provisions of the above mentioned enactment.
- b) TNPL is not liable for any injury or accident which may be caused to the operating crew or work men within the factory premises. It is therefore the responsibility of the Transporter to insure his Truck crew and workmen working at the TNPL factory adequately and Insurance Policy is to be produced to TNPL before commencing the work. ROAD SAFETY POLICY (un-named) should be taken by the successful transporter before commencement of work. This policy provides coverage for death due to any accident to the transporters' crew inside the premises upto ₹1,00,000/- and additionally ₹1,00,000/- towards Medical expenses for treatment of injury due to accident inside the mill premises. This is in addition to workmen compensation policy, which is currently being arranged by the transporter.

33. TNPL not responsible for transporter's Employees:

The transporter may employ such employees as he may think fit, and the employees so employed shall be the employees of the transporter, for all purposes, whatsoever, and shall not be deemed to be in the employment of TNPL for any purpose, whatsoever. The transporter should abide by all rules and regulations that may be enforced from time to time regarding the employment or working conditions of the employee.

- **34**. If under any circumstances whatsoever, TNPL is held liable or responsible in any manner, whatsoever for the default at omission on the part of the transporter in respect of any manner whatsoever, TNPL shall be reimbursed by the contractor for the same as also any other expenses or cost incurred by TNPL in any proceedings or litigation as a result of any claim, demand or act on the part of the employees of the transporter TNPL shall be entitles to claim damages or compensation from the transporter in that event
- **35**. The transporter is responsible to transport the material in sound condition and deliver to TNPL without any loss or damage. If any loss or damage occurs in transit, the transporter shall inform TNPL immediately within 24 hours from despatch of material from the mines, failing which TNPL reserves the right to make good the loss of material from the transporter and if need be resort to legal action depending on the merit of the case.
- **36**. TNPL reserves the right to engage any Additional Transporter, incase the transporter fails to mobilize sufficient number of Truck/Tipper and move the material as per our requirement. In such an event any additional expenditure that may be incurred will be recovered from the transporter.
- **37**. In case of any failure on your part, TNPL reserves the right to transport the materials through other sources and the any additional expenditure that may be incurred will be recovered from the transporter.
- **38**. In case the transporter transports the material in diverted route due to diversion imposed by government authorities, Civil commotions / disobedience, strike, road roko, accident and other unexpected reasons/incidents, traffic jam etc. or any reasons like, no compensation for extra kilometers will be paid to the transporter.
