WHEREAS, in the true spirit of public service, these employees represent Alabama with a commitment to the highest level of ethics, performance, customer service and efficiency; and


WHEREAS, state employees exhibit their dedication each and every day, standing ready to render assistance with kindness and courage to their fellow Alabamians in times of need; and
