## **Environmental Information Regulations 2004**

With regards to your request for information received by the Department on 04 December 2023 that sought the following information:

During the period encompassing from May 2022 to the present day, in relation to the illegal dump situated at Mobuoy, Mobuoy Road, Derry: Any and all documentation relating to the illegal waste site City Industrial Waste, Campsie Sand and Gravel, its history, regulatory implications, liability or any other topic relating to the site that was presented to the Permanent Secretary for information or approval.

I can advise that the Department has completed its search and can confirm that it holds the information you requested, however, the Department has decided not to disclose some of the information for the following reasons:

The Department has decided not to disclose some of the information you requested as it considers:

- Regulation 12(4)(d) In relation to the disclosure of documents DAERA has considered the use of the exemption Regulation 12(4)(d) material in the course of completion, unfinished documents, and incomplete data in its deliberations.
- Regulation 12(4)(e) The Department wants to ensure free and frank discussions can take place on an issue that is still under active consideration.
- Regulation 12(5)(b) while the criminal proceedings in relation to sentencing are extant and remain live the Department is not able to release the information requested.

An associated Public Interest Test has been conducted and is attached.

In addition, Regulation 12(3) and 13(1) is engaged as some of the information held constitutes personal data of which you are not the data subject. In these instances, the Department is required to consider if disclosure would breach the first Data Protection Principle which states that processing must be lawful, fair and transparent.

The Department has considered this element within the Lawfulness test which is attached and it has determined that no lawful basis for disclosure under EIR exists, bearing in mind that any such disclosure must be considered in terms of disclosure to the "world at large", and not just you the requester. Consequently, the personal data falling within the scope of this request has been withheld.


