DANONE €13,000,000,000 Euro Medium Term Note Programme

This first prospectus supplement (the "**First Prospectus Supplement**") constitutes a first prospectus supplement to and must be read in conjunction with the base prospectus dated 18 May 2022 prepared by Danone (the "**Issuer**" or "**Danone**") in relation to its \in 13,000,000,000 Euro Medium Term Note Programme (the "**Programme**") which received approval number 22-159 from the *Autorité des marchés financiers* (the "**AMF**") on 18 May 2022 (the "**Base Prospectus**"). Unless the context otherwise requires, terms defined in the Base Prospectus have the same meaning when used in this First Prospectus Supplement.

Application has been made for approval of this First Prospectus Supplement to the AMF in its capacity as competent authority under Regulation (EU) 2017/1129 of the European Parliament and of the European Council of 14 June 2017 (the "**Prospectus Regulation**").

This First Prospectus Supplement has been prepared pursuant to article 23 of the Prospectus Regulation, for the purposes of (i) incorporating by reference the Issuer's 2022 Interim Financial Report and (ii) as a consequence, amending and supplementing the "Risk Factors", "Documents Incorporated by Reference" and "General Information" sections of the Base Prospectus.

Save as disclosed in this First Prospectus Supplement, there has been no other significant new factor, material mistake or material inaccuracy relating to information included in the Base Prospectus which may affect the assessment of the Notes since the publication of the Base Prospectus.

To the extent there is any inconsistency between (a) any statement in this First Prospectus Supplement and (b) any other statement in or incorporated by reference in the Base Prospectus, the statements in (a) above will prevail.
