Inyo County Public Works has identified and prioritized 24 badly damaged roads which are used regularly to access communities, resources, and otherwise serve more regular “front-country” uses on a daily basis. We recognize there are additional dirt roads throughout the County which serve important recreation and backcountry access purposes. Despite the opening of Death Valley National Park, Saline Valley Road falls into the latter category. It is Inyo County’s intent to repair this and other outlying roads, however, we cannot speak to the timeframe for doing so until some of the higher priority work has been completed.
