THE GREEN VALLEY ROAD MULTI-USE TRAIL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT BEGINS

Improving Safety for all Multimodal Commuters

July 16, 2024 – Santa Cruz, CA – The County of Santa Cruz Department of Community Development & Infrastructure is pleased to announce that it has commenced its Green Valley Road Multi-Use Trail Improvement Project.

This project will take place on Green Valley Road, spanning from Holohan Drive to Casserly Road in Watsonville and is scheduled now through Friday, February 28, 2025, weather permitting. The road will be subject to lane closures from 8:30 AM – 4:30 PM on weekdays only to facilitate the improvements.

Once completed, this project will replace the dilapidated trail with a pervious, two-way, multi-use trail, providing a safe and accessible connection between the City of Watsonville and Santa Cruz unincorporated areas nearby. Additionally, the project will upgrade five Santa Cruz METRO bus stops with shelters.
