Ribbon Cutting at Eklutna Lake to Celebrate New Parking Lot and Improved Lakeside Trail

(Eklutna Lake, AK) – Alaskans are invited to join us as we celebrate updates to Chugach State Park's Eklutna Lake facility: a new and expanded parking area, and the completion of the Eklutna Lakeside Trail Improvements project.

With funding from the state legislature, Alaska Trails realigned and rebuilt sections of this popular motorized and multi-use trail where it had collapsed into Eklutna Lake. Through collaboration with the Alaska Department of Fish and Game Hunter Access Program and the Recreation Trails Program, Alaska State Parks was able to expand and pave the ATV parking lot, ensuring more Alaskans and visitors can recreate at Eklutna Lake on approved motorized-use days.

legislators, the Dunleavy Administration, Department of Natural Resources, Alaska State Parks, foundations supporting trails, local governments, and the

public.

VISUALS: Government officials talking about trails and holding a Golden Shovel to break


ground for this trail improvement project. Gorgeous scenes of Chugach
