SUSPENSION ORDER

On this day, the above styled matter came before Alan McClain, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner ("Commissioner"). The Arkansas Insurance Department was represented by Amanda Gibson, Managing Attorney in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds and concludes as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jayden Woodrow ("Respondent") holds a resident producer license, NPN 20997766, and is a resident of Fayetteville.
2. On September 18, 2024, the Department received notice from the Arkansas Office of Child Support Enforcement that the Respondent is three or more months in arrearage on his child support obligations and directed the Department to suspend any license held by the Respondent.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.
 2. The Commissioner is required by Ark. Code Ann. § 9-14-239(d) to suspend an insurance producer's license upon notice from the Arkansas Office of Child Support
-

Enforcement that a license is three or more months in arrears on a child support obligation.

3. Under the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(14), the failure to comply with an order imposing child support obligations is grounds for suspension or revocation of an insurance producer license. As described above, Respondent is in violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(14).

A Notice of Public Hearing is being served upon the Respondent simultaneously with this Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

That Respondent's nonresident producer license, NPN 20997766 is hereby SUSPENDED. Respondent shall not, during the term of this suspension, conduct the business of insurance in the State of Arkansas. This Order shall be rescinded upon receiving proof from the Arkansas Office of Child Support Enforcement that Respondent is in full compliance with his obligations under any child support order.
