SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY AND AUDIOLOGY AND HEARING AID DISPENSERS BOARD ANNOUNCES INTERIM EXECUTIVE OFFICER

SACRAMENTO—The Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology and Hearing Aid Dispensers Board (Board) has named Cherise Burns as its interim executive officer, effective November 6, 2024. Ms. Burns has served as assistant executive officer for the Board since January 2020.
