Election Order 2024-04

Re: Recount of State House Representative District 19

Date: November 27, 2024

Operative Facts

On Tuesday, November 5, 2024, a General Election was held, which included a race to determine the State House Representative for District 19. Election results for this race were audited in accordance with section 1-7-515 C.R.S., and that audit confirmed the results of the election. Weld and Boulder counties canvassed their election results, including for House District 19, in accordance with Colorado law. The canvass results for Weld and Boulder were submitted on November 26 and 27, 2024, respectively. At the conclusion of the tabulation of the House District 19 race, Dan Woog received 50.10% (28,419 votes) and Jillaire McMillan received 49.90% (28,310 votes). Pursuant to Colorado law, the percentage of vote totals between the candidates requires the Secretary of State to order a recount. Section 1-10.5-101, C.R.S.

Order

1. As required by section 1-10.5-102 (1), C.R.S. I hereby order a recount of the House District 19 race.
2. The recount must be completed no later than Friday, December 6, 2024, as required by section 1-10.5-102(2), C.R.S.
3. Because a certified voting system was used for the initial tabulation, the counties must re-scan all ballot cards counted during the initial tabulation.

4. Within 24 hours of the issuance of this Election Order, each county shall provide to the Election Division of the Secretary of State's Office the dates and times the county expects to begin, conduct, and complete its recount. Each county clerk must immediately notify the Election Division in writing if its recount schedule changes for any reason.
