

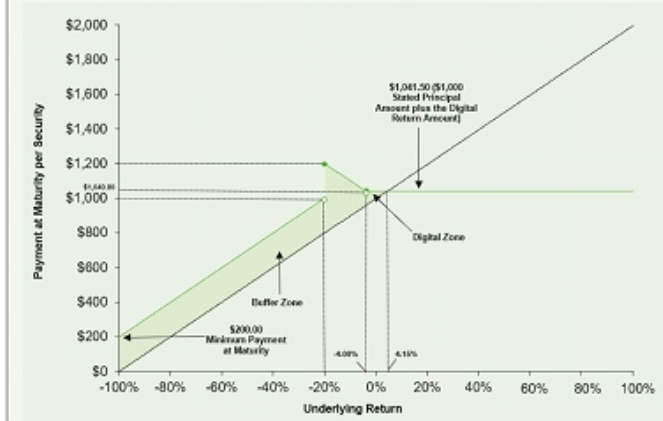

Selected Risk Considerations
