DOC announces inmate death

Smyrna, **DE** -- The Delaware Department of Correction (DOC) today announced that **Antonio Delgado**, a 67-year-old inmate from James T. Vaughn Correctional Center (JTVCC), died on Monday October 7, 2024.

Delgado had been receiving medical care at Bayhealth Hospital, Kent Campus, where he was transported for treatment on September 28, 2024, due to chronic health conditions.

His condition continued to deteriorate, and Delgado was pronounced dead at Bayhealth Hospital, Kent Campus on October 7, 2024, at 5:03 a.m. Delgado's body was turned over to the Division of Forensic Science to determine cause of death.

Delgado, from Dover, DE, has been in DOC custody since December 1991 serving a Life Sentence for 1st Degree Attempted Murder.
