DOC announces inmate death

Georgetown, DE -- The Delaware Department of Correction (DOC) today announced the death Scott Miller, a 56 year-old inmate with chronic health conditions from Sussex Correctional Institution (SCI).

On Sunday, November 3, Miller reported symptoms of illness and was assessed by facility medical staff. Emergency Medical Services were contacted, responded to the facility and transported Miller via ambulance to Beebe Hospital for further assessment and treatment. While receiving in-patient treatment, Miller's condition deteriorated and he was pronounced dead at 7:50 a.m. on November 5. His body was turned over to the Division of Forensic Science to determine cause of death.

Miller, of Dover, DE has been in DOC custody since May 13, 2024, and was being held as a pre-trial detainee on charges of Rape 1st Degree, Sexual Abuse of a Child, and Continuous Sexual Abuse of a Child.
