STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS CERTIFIES RESULTS OF NOV. 5 ELECTION

SPRINGFIELD (Dec. 2, 2024) - Statewide voter turnout for the Nov. 5 election was 70 percent, according to the official vote total certified today by the Illinois State Board of Elections.

The official total showed 5,705,246 of the state's 8,101,424 registered voters cast ballots in the election, resulting in a statewide voter turnout of 70.42 percent. Turnout was the fourth lowest of the last 48 years. (See turnout charts below.)

The only statewide office on the ballot was for President of the United States. In that race, Vice President Kamala Harris won Illinois' 19 electoral votes with 3,062863 votes (54.37 percent) to 2,449,079 (43.47 percent) for former President Donald Trump.

Illinois voters also responded affirmatively to three statewide advisory questions on the ballot.

Also on the state primary ballot were 118 representative and 24 senatorial seats in the Illinois General Assembly, 17 congressional seats and judicial races at all levels including the first and fourth Illinois Supreme Court districts.

Nearly 1 million voters are estimated to have cast their ballots by mail in the 2024 General Election, the highest number ever outside of the 2020 General Election, when pandemic restrictions resulted in more than 2 million ballots being cast by mail. (The vote-by-mail estimate is based on data provided by 101 of the state's 108 local election authorities and pre-election reports. The full mail voting report, to be submitted to the U.S. Election Assistance Commission and containing data from all election authorities, will be <u>published on the SBE website</u> on Dec. 4.)

Nearly 2 million voters cast ballots in person during early voting between Sept. 26 and Nov. 4. That number also was the highest ever outside of 2020, when early voting totaled nearly 2.01 million ballots. (See chart below for mail and early voting trends from 2004-2024.)

The State Board of Elections is an independent state agency charged with the responsibility of having general supervision over the administration of election laws of the State of Illinois. Elections are administered locally by the state's 108 election authorities.
