## Illinois 113 railroad crossing in Coal City closes October 7

**OTTAWA** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that Illinois 113 will be closed for repairs at the BNSF Railroad crossing in Coal City on Monday, October 7th. The closure will be for approximately five days.

A posted detour will direct eastbound Illinois 113 traffic to use Broadway Street, North Street and First Avenue. Westbound Illinois 113 traffic will use Fifth Avenue, North Street and Broadway Street.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area and be prepared for slow and stopped traffic. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
