Illinois 176 closing at rail crossing in Mundelein

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that repairs by the Canadian National Railroad to a crossing on Illinois 176 (Maple Avenue) east of U.S. 45 (Lake Street), in Mundelein, will require a full closure starting, weather permitting, 9 a.m. Friday, Sept. 20.

A detour will direct motorists to U.S. 45, Butterfield and Winchester roads. The work is being overseen by the railroad and expected to be completed by 9 a.m. Sunday, Sept. 29.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to detour signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
