Work on Illinois 2 in Byron begins July 24

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that weather permitting, construction on Illinois 2 over Mill Creek near Byron in Ogle County will begin Wednesday, July 24.

Work includes replacing the bridge joints and repairing the bridge deck. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in the work zone and will be controlled by temporary traffic signals. This project is expected to be completed by the end of September.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the <u>next six years</u>, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,000 miles of highway and nearly 10 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. <u>Accomplishments</u> through Year Four of Rebuild Illinois included approximately \$12.1 billion of improvements statewide on 5,339 miles of highway, 533 bridges and 762 additional safety improvements.
