Illinois 116 ramp to Illinois 29 to close June 30

East Peoria guardrail work to last 2-3 hours

EAST PEORIA – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that the ramp from eastbound Illinois 116 (Cedar Street) to westbound Illinois 29/U.S. 24 (Main Street) in East Peoria will close at 9 a.m. June 30.

The closure is necessary for guardrail repairs and is expected to last about two to three hours. Because of the short duration of the closure, no detour will be posted.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,500 miles of highway and 9 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Two included approximately \$5.2 billion of improvements statewide on 3,020 miles of highway, 270 bridges and 428 additional safety improvements.
