Illinois 59 over I-90 bridge repairs begin Aug. 5

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that repairs to the bridge carrying Illinois 59 (Sutton Road) over Interstate 90, in Hoffman Estates, will begin, weather permitting, Monday, Aug. 5.

To complete the work, lane closures will take place on Sutton Road between Shoe Factory Road and Hoffman Boulevard. At least one lane in each direction will remain open throughout construction. The public also should expect various lane shifts on both sides of Sutton Road approaching the bridge and occasional overnight lane closures on the I-90 at the bridge during that time.

The \$2.5 million project, which consists of repairing the bridge deck, installing a new deck overlay, replacing expansion joints and deteriorated shoulders, is anticipated to be completed in November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,200 miles of highway and nearly 9 million square feet of bridge deck as part of Rebuild Illinois, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Five of Rebuild Illinois include approximately \$16 billion of improvements statewide on 6,541 miles of highway, 686 bridges and 986 additional safety improvements.
