Lake Street bridge repairs begin Aug. 5

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that repairs to the bridge carrying Lake Street (U.S. 20) over Illinois Route 390 Tollway, in Hanover Park, will begin, weather permitting, Monday, Aug. 5.

To complete the work, lane closures will take place on Lake Street between Greenbrook Boulevard and Ontarioville Road/Bear Flag Drive. At least one lane in each direction will remain open throughout construction. The public also should expect various lane shifts on both sides of Lake Street approaching the bridge.

The \$1.9 million project, which consists of repairing the bridge deck, replacing expansion joints, pavement patching and installing a new deck overlay, is anticipated to be completed in November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Alternative routes are encouraged. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,200 miles of highway and nearly 9 million square feet of bridge deck as part of Rebuild Illinois, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Five of Rebuild Illinois include approximately \$16 billion of improvements statewide on 6,541 miles of highway, 686 bridges and 986 additional safety improvements.
