Early Voting Returns to Kalamazoo County for November General Election

KALAMAZOO, Mich. – Starting on Saturday, Oct. 26, and concluding on Sunday, Nov. 3, in-person early voting for the Nov. 5 General Election will be available at four strategically located sites across Kalamazoo County from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.:

- **Kalamazoo County Expo Center** – 2900 Lake St., Kalamazoo, MI 49048
- **Portage Parks & Recreation Department** – 320 Library Lane, Portage, MI 49002
- **Fetzer Center at Western Michigan University** – 2251 Business Court, Kalamazoo, MI 49008
- **Douglass Community Association** – 1000 W Paterson St., Kalamazoo, MI 49007

The adoption of Proposal 2022-2 requires a minimum of nine days of available early in-person voting to allow voters in Kalamazoo County* flexibility to cast their ballots ahead of Election Day.
