## **Kalamazoo County Senior Expo Returns for 25th Year**

KALAMAZOO, Mich. – Serving older adults as a community resource hub for a quarter-century, the Kalamazoo County Senior Expo returns to the Kalamazoo County Expo Center from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 1.

The free event, organized by the Kalamazoo County Health & Community Services Department's Area Agency on Aging Region 3A Division (AAA3A), features over 100 exhibitors representing various agencies tailored to meet the unique needs of older adults living in Kalamazoo County.

"Over the past 25 years, the Senior Expo has connected tens of thousands of older adults to the resources necessary to age in place as active members of their community," Don Saldia, AAA3A Division Manager said. "This enduring success is a clear indication of the robust support available to older adults living in Kalamazoo County, largely due to funding sources like the Senior Millage."

Senior Millage-funded programs help to keep older adults in their homes for as long as possible with the support of local organizations. Administered by the AAA3A, the Senior Millage provides in-home services, care management, education, safety, dignity, independence, and healthy living programs for Kalamazoo County residents aged 60 and above.
