Detroit Man Charged in Fatal Shooting of Wife

On July 29, 2024, Prosecutor Kym Worthy charged George Douglas Thomas, 72, of Detroit, in connection with the fatal shooting of his wife, Sharonda Davis-Thomas, 53.

On July 26, 2024, at approximately 4:46 p.m., Detroit police officers were dispatched to a residence in the 19400 block of Five Points Street for a reported shooting. Upon their arrival, officers observed the victim in the driveway of the home, suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Medics arrived on the scene and transported the victim to a local hospital for treatment where she succumbed to her injuries and was pronounced deceased.

It is alleged that Defendant Thomas produced and fired a handgun multiple times at the victim, fatally wounding her.

George Douglas Thomas has been charged with First-Degree Murder and Felony Firearm.*

He was arraigned and remanded to jail on July 30, 2024, in 36th District Court. Defendant Thomas was referred for a competency evaluation at the Probable Cause Conference on August 6, 2024. His next court date is a Competency Hearing on November 6, 2024, at 8:35 a.m., before Judge Kenneth King.
