Submission of the First National Report on the Implementation of the Nagoya Protocol

Dear Sir or Madam,

In decision [NP-4/3](#), paragraph 5, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Nagoya Protocol (COP-MOP) requests Parties to the Protocol to submit a first national report on the implementation of the Nagoya Protocol, as called for in [Article 29](#) of the Protocol, at the same time as the seventh national reports under the Convention are due. The decision also welcomes submissions of relevant information by non-Parties.

Pursuant to the above decision, Parties are invited to submit their first national report online through the [ABS Clearing-House](#) no later than **28 February 2026**, in one of the official languages of the United Nations, and using the submission format available on the ABS Clearing-House at the following link: <https://absch.cbd.int/en/register/NR1/new>. Information related to the preparation and submission of the report is available at [this webpage](#). Non-Parties are also invited to submit relevant information to secretariat@cbd.int.

Information submitted through the first national reports, as well as through the ABS Clearing-House, will be analysed for the consideration of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Nagoya Protocol at its sixth meeting, and will serve as a contribution to the second assessment and review of the effectiveness of the Protocol. Parties are also encouraged to use the opportunity of the preparation of their first national report to verify that their national records in the ABS Clearing-House are complete and up to date. Financial support for the preparation of the first national report

Kindly note that letters of endorsement **must be received by 30 August 2024** for a Party to be included in the project proposal.
