Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. EXTENDED STREET CLOSURE

Weekdays & Saturdays

Dates: Saturday, October 12 to Saturday, November 2, 2024

Location: W. Balmoral Avenue between N. Broadway and N. Winthrop Avenue

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm; continuous (24/7) street closure

Work Activity: Street & Sidewalk Restoration

Local Impact:

- W. Balmoral Avenue between N. Broadway and N. Winthrop Avenue will be closed to vehicular and bicycle traffic
- Local traffic will be permitted outside the work zone from N. Broadway or from N. Winthrop Avenue as the work activity allows.
- Sidewalk closures within the work zone will alternate between the north and south sides of the street.
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times.
- Access to the front garage door at 1122 W. Balmoral Avenue (Euro Collision of Andersonville) will be maintained (*The contractor will coordinate ahead of time if there is a need to temporarily block access*).
- Access to the alleys on the north side of W. Balmoral Avenue will be maintained via W. Catalpa Avenue at all times.
- Access to the alley on the south side of W. Balmoral Avenue will be maintained via W. Berwyn Avenue at all times (*any direct alley impact will be communicated via separate Construction Activity Notice*).
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Loud noise from roadway and sidewalk demolition
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
