Update on Stabbing Death in Mira Mesa

On July 12, 2024, at approximately 3:25 a.m., Officers from Northern Division responded to a local hospital to investigate a report of a male who had been stabbed. The male had been brought to the hospital by a female. The male was rushed into treatment but, despite the best efforts of medical personnel, the male was pronounced deceased.

During their preliminary investigation, Officers learned that the possible location of the stabbing was a residence in the 11000 block of Mont Blanc Drive in Mira Mesa. Officers from Northeastern Division responded and discovered the likely stabbing scene inside the residence.

The preliminary information gathered shows that the male and female are believed to be in a dating relationship. There was some type of argument at the residence. During that argument, a knife was present and the male suffered a fatal stab wound.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene to investigate. Detectives continue to examine the exact events that led up to the male being stabbed. This remains an ongoing investigation.

The male is now identified as Reginald Hancock Jr. He is described as a 40-year-old Black male.

The female that was involved in the argument was arrested and booked into jail for murder. She is now identified as Brena Siquiera. She is described as a 27-year-old Brazilian female.
