Arrest Made in 2023 Ocean Beach Homicide

San Diego – Following an extensive investigation, detectives have made an arrest in a 2023 Ocean Beach homicide.

On May 10, 2023, at approximately 10:51 p.m., Sean Glenn was standing on the sidewalk at 5000 Newport Avenue. A man walked up and punched Glenn, knocking him unconscious. Glenn was transported to the hospital for his injuries. Western Division Detectives began investigating the assault.

Glenn remained hospitalized until August 5, 2023, but ultimately died from his injuries. He was described as a 35-year-old white male.

Upon Glenn's death, San Diego Police Homicide Division assumed responsibility for the investigation. Assisted by significant video images of the assault and the attacker, detectives identified Andrew Restrepo, described as a 36-year-old Hispanic man, as the suspect in the case. Detectives also learned Restrepo was responsible for a similar attack on a yet to be identified man later that same month while riding an MTS bus in the Midway area.

On August 27, 2024, at 2:07 p.m., Restrepo was located at 402 Fifth Avenue and arrested for both assaults. He was booked into County Jail for one count of murder, two counts of assault with force likely to result in great bodily injury, and various other related charges.
