

Texas Advisory and Notification System (TXANS)

A communications tool that delivers clear and reliable information on ERCOT grid conditions.

TXANS will:

- Serve as a resource to the public to follow ERCOT grid conditions
- Introduce the ERCOT Weather Watch
- Inform the public on grid condition levels and of any public action needed
- Keep all Texans informed through various communications channels

What is an ERCOT Weather Watch?

An ERCOT Weather Watch is an earlier (approximately 3-5 days ahead) notification of forecasted significant weather and high demand.



When is an ERCOT Weather Watch issued?

ERCOT will continue to monitor forecasted conditions, and if conditions determine a need, ERCOT may issue an ERCOT Weather Watch.



What to do when an ERCOT Weather Watch is issued

Continue to monitor grid conditions. View tips at ERCOT.com/TXANS on how to save on your energy usage during forecasted high demand periods.

VOLUNTARY CONSERVATION NOTICE



What is a Voluntary Conservation Notice?

A Voluntary Conservation Notice is a call for Texans to voluntarily reduce energy usage during peak demand, if safe to do so.



When is a Voluntary Conservation Notice issued?

ERCOT will continue to monitor forecasted conditions, and if conditions determine a need, ERCOT may issue a Voluntary Conservation Notice.



What to do when a Voluntary Conservation Notice is issued

Voluntarily conserve power during specific conservation period, if safe to do so. View tips at ERCOT.com/TXANS on how to save on your energy usage during forecasted high demand periods.
