A hoax message has been making rounds, claiming that there will be a serious storm that will hit the Nelson Mandel Bay areas around 3pm today. This statement is **false**, and it is **misleading**.

A good chance of showers and rain (80%) is expected over Nelson Mandela Bay Metro today (22 October 2024), but the intensity of the rain is expected to become light from the afternoon.

We are **not** expecting more than 20mm for the rest of the day. There's an orange level 6 warning for disruptive rain for the Metro, which is valid for the rest of the day, due to the significant amounts of rainfall already received. Although this is the case, other portions of the Eastern Cape coast may get heavy downpours particularly between Buffalo City Metro and Mnguma LM from this afternoon.
