## Key figures related to the insurance claims paid for typhoons and windstorms in fiscal 2023

The General Insurance Association of Japan (GIAJ) has released the figures for claims paid for typhoons and windstorms in fiscal 2023.

## (1) Heavy rainfall due to a "Baiu" front (rainy season front) and Typhoon No. 2 (Mawar), 2023 (occurred on June 1-3, 2023)

The numbers represent the total combined figures for member companies of the General Insurance Association of Japan and the Foreign Non-Life Insurance Association of Japan, etc. as of March 31, 2024
