Flood Warning Issued for the State of Grenada

St. George's, Grenada – Tuesday, November 19, 2024. 4:00 P.M.

NaDMA reminds the general public that the Meteorological Office has issued a flood and landslide warning for the state of Grenada for today, Tuesday, November 19th, 2024. This is as a result of a surface trough in the vicinity of the Windward Islands.

Moisture and instability associated with the surface trough will continue to affect the island chain. Consequently, the flood and landslide warning remain in effect. If there is additional rainfall this evening and tonight, the chances of landslides and flooding will increase.

The Meteorological Services and the National Disaster Management Agency (NaDMA) will continue to monitor the situation and provide timely updates.

Citizens are urged to be vigilant, monitor the weather conditions, and pay attention to the information issued by the Meteorological Office and NaDMA.
