H.E. DR. MUSALIA MUDAVADI TO ATTEND TICAD'S MINISTERIAL MEETING IN TOKYO.

- H.E. Dr. Musalia Mudavadi, Prime Cabinet Secretary and Cabinet Secretary for Foreign & Diaspora Affairs today left for Tokyo, Japan to attend the Tokyo International Conference on African Development (TICAD) 9th Ministerial Meeting.
- 2. The 9th TICAD Ministerial Meeting is organized, in conjunction with the United Nations (UN), the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), the World Bank (WB), and the African Union Commission (AUC).
- 3. During the meeting, Prime Cabinet Secretary and Cabinet Secretary for Foreign and Diaspora Affairs will speak on Promoting Trade, and Investment, and underscore the Government of Kenya's interests in line with the implementation of the Bottom-Up Economic Transformation Agenda (BETA).
- 4. The Prime Cabinet Secretary and Cabinet Secretary for Foreign and Diaspora Affairs will seek to showcase opportunities available for investment in Kenya by the Japanese private sector.
- 5. He will use the opportunity to call for international cooperation in response to climate change, achievement of the Sustainable development Goals (SDGs), and the reforms of the international financing architecture.
- 6. On the sidelines of the meeting, the Prime Cabinet Secretary will hold bilateral meetings with H.E. Ms. Yoko Kamikawa, Minister for Foreign Affairs, Japan, H.E. Sara Beysolow, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Liberia,

- and H.E Ms. Yassine Fall, Minister for African Integration and Foreign Affairs, Republic of Senegal.
- 7. Also, the Prime Cabinet Secretary will hold meetings with: Dr. Tanaka Akihiko, President of Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), Mr. Toshimitsu Imai, Executive Vice President, Toyota Tsusho Corporation Mr. Yoji Okumura, President & CEO Fujita Corporation, Dr. Sania Nishtar, Chief Executive Officer, GAVI the Vaccine Alliance and a Media Interview with Nikkei Asia.
- 8. Kenya's participation at the upcoming TICAD 9 Ministerial meeting presents an opportunity to enhance the existing relationship between Kenya and Japan through the TICAD framework.
