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K-32 bridge demolition requires Kaw Drive closure tomorrow in Wyandotte County

Kansas Department of Transportation bridge demolition requires closure of eastbound K-32 (Kaw Drive), from 65th Street to 59th Lane, at 2 p.m. Friday, Dec. 1. Eastbound K-32 (Kaw Drive) is expected to reopen to traffic by 6 p.m. Saturday, Dec. 2, weather permitting.

This closure is necessary for demolition of the existing westbound K-32/Turner Diagonal Freeway bridge as part of the K-32/Turner Diagonal Freeway bridge replacement project over Kaw Drive and Union Pacific Railroad tracks.

Message boards have been placed in the area to notify motorists of the upcoming closure.

The following will be fully closed to traffic on Friday, Dec. 1 at 2 p.m.:

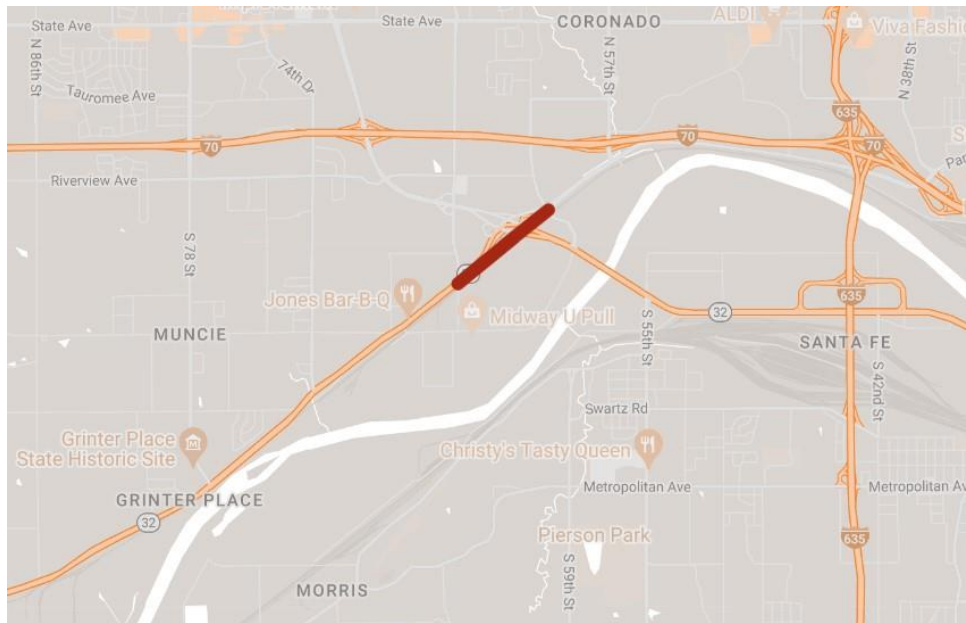
- **Eastbound K-32 (Kaw Drive), from 65th Street to 59th Lane.**

A detour will be marked as follows: eastbound K-32 traffic will be directed to turn right onto Kansas Avenue and continue to 59th Lane, then turn right onto eastbound Kaw Drive.

Traffic will be controlled using changeable message boards, signs, channelizers and barricades.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas go to www.kandrive.gov or call 5-1-1. Drive safely and always wear your seat belt.
