Two-day closure planned for section of N. Hydraulic Avenue

On Wednesday, Oct. 23, the Kansas Department of Transportation will close a section of North Hydraulic Avenue in both directions in Wichita.


The closure is necessary to erect girders. The two-day project will begin at 7 a.m. and continue until 6 p.m. on Oct. 24, after which the road will reopen.

Motorists exiting westbound on K-96 onto North Hydraulic Avenue will be restricted to right turns toward East 37th Street, with no access south of 37th. The eastbound K-96 on-ramp from North Hydraulic Avenue will remain closed. The on- and off-ramps at Hydraulic Avenue and northbound/southbound I-135, will also be closed.

Businesses within the closure area will still have direct access to their facilities.

The map below outlines the project area and the detour route.
