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U.S. 183 to be resurfaced in Phillips County

The Kansas Department of Transportation plans to begin a resurfacing project on a portion of U.S. 183 in Phillips County starting on or around Sept. 18.

Project work will consist of a mill and overlay on 13 miles of the highway starting at the Rooks County line and ending at the east U.S. 36 junction. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in the areas where crews are actively working and directed by flaggers and a pilot car. Motorists should plan for delays of up to 15 minutes during daylight hours.

KDOT expects the project to be completed in late October, conditions permitting.
