Field survey will be underway on U.S. 24 in Osborne County

The Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a field survey on a 2.4-mile portion of U.S. 24 in Osborne County around Oct. 28.

Crews will work in the area of the U.S. 24 bridge over the Kyle Railroad about 1.5 miles east of the K-181/U.S. 24 junction.

The survey is necessary to gather supplemental information for the proposed bridge replacement project. Activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.

KDOT expects the work to be completed in mid-December.

Crews will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property if access is needed. Chad Marsh of Kirkham Michael will oversee the survey for KDOT.
