Traffic to be affected on Topeka highways

As part of the Kansas Department of Transportation's current bridge repair projects on U.S. 75 in Topeka, the following lane reductions and ramp closures are scheduled to occur:

Saturday, Sept. 14, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.:

- Both directions of U.S. 24 will be reduced to one lane in the area under U.S. 75.

Monday, Sept. 16, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.:

- Both directions of U.S. 24 will be reduced to one lane in the area under U.S. 75.
- Both directions of I-70 will be reduced to one lane under the U.S. 75 flyover bridges.

Tuesday, Sept. 17, from 4 a.m. to 6 a.m.:

- The southbound U.S. 75 flyover bridge to eastbound I-70 will be closed. Motorists can follow the marked detour to westbound I-70 to Fairlawn Road to eastbound I-70. Eastbound I-70 under the flyover bridge will also be reduced to one lane.

Tuesday, Sept. 17, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.:

- Both directions of U.S. 24 will be reduced to one lane in the area under U.S. 75.

Work hours are approximate and conditions permitting. Drivers should plan for delays and are encouraged to use alternate routes, if possible.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of highway construction projects across Kansas, go to www.KanDrive.gov or call 5-1-1.
