Traffic changes to begin next week on U.S. 24

Traffic changes are expected to begin next week on the Kansas Department of Transportation's U.S. 24 reconstruction project in north Topeka.

On Monday, Oct. 28, the shoo-fly detours that were used to shift eastbound U.S. 24 traffic onto the south frontage road will close. Eastbound traffic will then be reduced to one lane on the reconstructed highway. The south frontage road will return to its original head-tohead configuration.

Eastbound U.S. 24 will be able to access the south frontage road and businesses along the corridor.

Westbound U.S. 24 will continue to be two lanes on the north frontage road.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of highway construction projects across Kansas, go to www.KanDrive.gov or call 5-1-1.
