Eastbound and westbound I-435 will fully close this weekend for bridge demolition in Johnson County

Eastbound and westbound I-435, from Quivira Road to Antioch Road in Johnson County, will be <u>fully</u> <u>closed to traffic</u> beginning at 7 p.m. on Friday, Aug. 23, weather permitting.

Additionally, ramps for westbound I-435 to southbound U.S. 69, eastbound I-435 to northbound U.S. 69, and northbound U.S. 69 to westbound I-435 will be **fully closed**. All lanes and ramps will reopen by Monday, Aug. 26 at 6 a.m.

This temporary closure is necessary for bridge demolition. The work is part of the KDOT U.S. 69 Expansion Project (69Express). All scheduled project work is weather permitting and subject to change.

During the closure, detours will be marked as follows:

Eastbound I-435 traffic:

- Travel eastbound I-435 to the southbound U.S. 69 ramp
- Take southbound U.S. 69 to the College Boulevard exit ramp
- From College Boulevard, use the northbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp
- Head north on U.S. 69 to use the eastbound I-435 ramp
- Continue eastbound on I-435

Westbound I-435 traffic:

- Travel westbound I-435 to the northbound U.S. 69 ramp
- Take northbound U.S. 69 to the 103rd Street exit ramp
- Drive west along 103rd Street
- Use the 103rd Street to southbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp
- Head south on U.S. 69 to use the westbound I-435 ramp
- Continue westbound on I-435

Map below shows closure locations marked in red and the detour routes marked in blue, green, orange and purple.



The 69Express project includes reconstruction of U.S. 69, widening the highway with added express lanes – one in each direction between 151st and 103rd Streets – and interchange improvements at U.S. 69/167th Street in Overland Park.
