U.S. 169 crack seal project starts this month

Monday, Sept. 16, the Kansas Department of Transportation expects to begin a crack seal project on 9.3 miles of U.S. 169 in Anderson County. The project starts 1.5 miles south of Welda and continues north to the junction of U.S. 59/U.S. 169 at Garnett.

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one-lane traffic through the work zone; expect delays of 15 minutes or less during weekday daylight hours. Weather permitting, the road work should be finished by late October.

KDOT awarded Pavement Pro's LLC, McPherson, the construction contract of \$136.072.
