## U.S. 169 (7<sup>th</sup> Street) over Kansas River bridge repair project begins Monday in Wyandotte County

A Kansas Department of Transportation bridge repair project on southbound U.S. 169 (7<sup>th</sup> Street) over the Kansas River is scheduled to begin Monday, Sept. 16, in Wyandotte County, weather permitting.

The bridge expansion joint repair project, over the levee along the north side of the Kansas River, is expected to be completed in approximately three weeks. Work is scheduled during daylight hours, Monday through Friday.


While work is taking place, southbound U.S. 169 (7<sup>th</sup> Street) will be reduced to a single lane and the open U.S. 169 (7<sup>th</sup> Street) lane will have a **12-foot lane width restriction**.

Traffic will be controlled using portable message signs, signage and traffic cones. Message boards are in place notifying motorists of the project.

R.A. Knapp Construction, of Kansas City, Mo., is the contractor for the \$84,000 project.
