K-42 reconstruction, detour to begin soon in Pratt County

A K-42 pavement reconstruction will start soon at Sawyer, in Pratt County.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project will be from the K-42/U.S. 281 junction to the east city limits of Sawyer.

The work is expected to begin around Monday, July 29, and be completed around Oct. 9.

During the work, K-42 will be closed through Sawyer, and motorists will be directed to an official state detour on U.S. 281, U.S. 54/400 and K-14.


KDOT uses state highways for official detour routes for safety, weight and maintenance concerns.
