
Survey for U.S. 169 improvements to begin in Anderson County

The Kansas Department of Transportation expects the week of Aug. 12 to begin a survey for passing lanes and wider shoulders at selected locations on U.S. 169 in Anderson County. The survey area starts at the north U.S. 59/U.S. 169 junction and continues northeast to the Franklin County line.

Surveyors will gather the information necessary for a detailed design of the proposed improvements. The approximate length of the survey is 16 miles on the existing highway alignment. Weather permitting, the survey should be completed by January 2025.

Activities include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property. William Kenter of SAM will manage the survey for KDOT.
