U.S. 166 resurfacing project begins Wednesday

On Wednesday, Oct. 2, the Kansas Department of Transportation plans to start resurfacing work on U.S. 166 in Montgomery County. The mill and overlay project will begin at the east junction with U.S. 169 at Coffeyville and continues east for 3.3 miles to end at the Labette County line.

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one-lane traffic through the work zone during daylight hours; expect delays of 15 minutes or less. Weather permitting, the work should be finished by late October.

KDOT awarded the \$1.1 million construction contract to Pearson Construction, Wichita.
