KDOT hosts open house on K-68 expansion in Miami County

The Kansas Department of Transportation is hosting a public open house to share final design plans for the project that will expand a section of K-68 to four lanes in Miami County.

The open house will take place from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 10, at the Louisburg Middle School, 505 E. Amity St., Louisburg. There will be no formal presentation. Those attending can stop by at any time to view the materials and visit with project staff.

Spanning 6.68 miles of K-68 from U.S. 169 east to Spring Valley Road, the expansion project is one of several announced Eisenhower Legacy Transportation (IKE) projects in the Construction Pipeline for KDOT's Southeast District.
