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## KDOT updates schedule for eight IKE projects

The Kansas Department of Transportation released on Friday updated timelines for eight highway modernization and expansion projects in the Eisenhower Legacy Transportation Program's (IKE) Construction Pipeline.

The revised schedule for IKE, the state's 10-year transportation program, provides additional time to address specific project issues. These challenges include acquiring right-of-way, relocating utilities, managing construction cost inflation and addressing new concerns such as increased traffic when Kansas City hosts the 2026 FIFA World Cup.

"We will deliver every project in IKE's construction pipeline with the dedication and quality that Kansans expect from KDOT," **Secretary Calvin Reed said**. "Our focus is on building a reliable transportation network for our communities, and we recognize that large-scale programs such as IKE must be able to adapt to be successful."

Among the affected projects are the K-10/South Lawrence Trafficway in Douglas County and the U.S. 54/East Kellogg Corridor in Sedgwick and Butler counties.

Shifting the timeline on the west leg of the K-10/South Lawrence Trafficway from I-70 south to U.S. 40/6<sup>th</sup> Street in Douglas County allows for right-of-way acquisitions. This will reduce construction congestion around Lawrence during the World Cup in 2026.

A new schedule for the U.S. 54/East Kellogg Corridor also accommodates needed preconstruction activities, including right-of-way acquisitions and utility relocations.

"The ability to adjust IKE's timelines provides the flexibility to respond to challenges, maximize the value of every dollar invested and allows for consistent state contractor engagement," **Deputy Secretary Greg Schieber said.** 

KDOT will continue to provide updates on project timelines to keep the public informed.
