KDOT construction projects affecting traffic

KDOT Current Projects

- Update: Southbound I-135 from the K-254 interchange to just past the K-96 interchange will be closed starting at 5 a.m. on Saturday, Oct. 5.
 Northbound I-135 motorists will be required to exit onto eastbound K-96.
 The closures are necessary for girder erection and are expected to be completed by the late evening of Sunday, Oct. 6. Detours will direct drivers to take alternate routes.
- 2. New: Westbound U.S. 54 exit ramp to southbound I-135 will close starting on Monday, Sept. 30. Motorists should follow the signed detour on northbound I-135 to exit 6B and 2nd Street, then turn left on southbound I-135 to the west Kellogg exit 6A. Work is expected to conclude by late December.
- 3. Update: Eastbound U.S. 54 to I-135 northbound will had a ramp closure that began on Tuesday, July 23. The rehabilitation project will involve milling, patching and a concrete overlay being placed on each side consecutively. The bridge is set to reopen on Monday, Sept. 30, in coordination with the westbound U.S. 54 exit ramp to southbound I-135 closure.
- 4. New: Northbound I-135 from 2nd Street to 17th Street will have the left and center lanes closed beginning Friday, Oct. 4. The two-lane closure will occur until 5 a.m. Monday, at which time the center lane will reopen to commuters.
- 5. New: I-135 NB and SB bridges over Chisholm creek near mile marker 15 will have inspections starting at 10 a.m. on Monday, Sept. 30. The inspection will require the use of a snooper truck and is expected to take less than 2 hours.

- 6. New: I-135 Northbound Ramp to Westbound U.S. 54 will have a ramp closure starting at 9 a.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 1. The inspection will require the use of a snooper truck and will take place between 9 and 3 p.m.
- 7. New: U.S. 54 ramp to Southbound I-235 will have inspections on Wednesday, Oct. 2. The inspection will require the use of a snooper truck and will take place between 9 and 3 p.m.
- 8. New: U.S. 54 will have an inspection completed using a lift truck on Thursday, Oct. 3. Eastbound U.S. 54 will have the left and center lanes closed simultaneously from Washington Street to I-135, while westbound U.S. 54 will have the same closures from Hillside Street to I-135. The closures will then switch to the right lane. Each lane closure is expected to last approximately 45 minutes.
- 9. Central Street on-ramp and the 8th/9th Street off-ramp of northbound I-135 will be closed beginning Thursday, Sept. 19, at 9 a.m. Cones will be set up to include the acceleration and deceleration lanes between the two ramps. Ramps will remain closed until the work is completed.
- 10. Entrance ramp from E 13th Street of northbound I-135 closed starting July23. The rehabilitation project involves patching. The entrance ramp is scheduled to remain closed through September.
- 11. The East 77th Street bridge over I-135 will be closed for maintenance starting Monday, Sept. 9. It is estimated reconstruction will conclude in November.
- 12. Eastbound and westbound K-96 from Maize to I-235 will have intermittent lane closures starting Wednesday, Sept. 11. It is estimated reconstruction will conclude in early November.
- 13. Northbound I-235 to westbound K-96 will be closed for reconstruction starting Monday, Sept. 16. The work is expected to be completed in early October.
- 14. Northbound and southbound Eisenhower Airport Parkway will have the center and right lanes closed for maintenance starting Tuesday, Aug. 13, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. It is estimated that the project will be completed by October.
- 15. Exit 7B ramp to E 9th Street N of northbound I-135 will close starting Wednesday, August 21. The rehabilitation project will involve patching.
- 16. Northbound I-135 from 2nd Street to 17th Street will have the left lane closed beginning Sunday, August 25. The rehabilitation project will involve patching. Maintenance is set to conclude in early November.
- 17. According to the Kansas Turnpike Authority, Toll booth decommissioning began on July 1. KTA crews have been removing toll booths and canopies

for contractors to complete **demolition and lane reconfiguration**. Contract work will **begin** at these toll plazas **in August** and is expected to be **completed by the end of the year, weather permitting**.

- 18. Eastbound U.S. 54 from Hillside Street to Webb Road will have the left and center lane closed starting on Sunday, August 4. The work will generally occur from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday. When work is not occurring, the center lane will be reopened to the public. Maintenance is set to conclude in late December.
- 19. Westbound/eastbound U.S. 400 between 159th Street and Prairie Creek Road is conducting a *geological field survey* starting Monday, June 17. The study will gather information needed for the proposed East Kellogg Expansion Project and expected to be completed by early December.
- 20. N East 45th street bridge over I-135 will have the **westbound lane** closed beginning Monday, June 17. Maintenance is set to conclude in early October.
- 21. Westbound/eastbound U.S. 400 between K-96 and S Andover Road is conducting a *geological field survey*. The study will gather information needed for the proposed East Kellogg Expansion Project and is expected to be completed by August.

KDOT Multi-year Projects

- 1. Update: A Sedgwick County bridge repair project on Zoo Boulevard over the Mitch Mitchell Floodway construction has been completed.
- 2. Gold Project Phase 2B: North Junction to I-135/K-96 Interchange on I-135 and K-96 Construction began Feb. 6, 2023, with completion currently slated for late 2026. This phase includes a direct link for eastbound K-96 from northbound I-235 and southbound I-135, new westbound K-96 ramps to I-135 and other new ramps at K-96 and I-135 interchange.
 - A long-term 11-foot width restriction on the two lanes of southbound I-135, south of the I-235/K-254 overpass, is in effect (along with a 50-mph work zone speed limit).
 - Southbound I-135 exit to eastbound K-96 has an 11-foot width restriction. Started March 8, 2023. Long-term Width Restriction
- Concrete pavement patching on I-235 from the South Junction with I-135 to N.
 Meridian began April 23. Work hours are Sundays 1 p.m. to 6 a.m. Mondays –
 Thursdays 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

4. K-96 Improvements Project, upgrading the K-96 corridor between I-135 and I-35.
