Overnight closure scheduled on U.S. 75 ramp

Conditions permitting, the Kansas Department of Transportation will temporarily close a U.S. 75 ramp in Topeka in the early morning hours of Friday, Nov. 8.

The southbound U.S. 75 flyover bridge to eastbound I-70/Gage Boulevard will be closed from 2 a.m. to 6 a.m. while safety netting is installed. A marked detour will direct motorists to westbound I-70, Fairlawn Road, back to eastbound I-70.

During the closure, eastbound I-70 under the flyover bridge will also be reduced to one lane. The eastbound I-70 exit to northbound U.S. 75 and Gage Boulevard will remain open.
